Divisions

Hunter Optimum - The course will be well flagged, easy to follow, approximately 5 miles in length. Jumps not to exceed 3 ft. and all will be optional.

Hilltoppers – This division will follow the same course with “go arounds” at each jump. This slower division is encouraged to start earlier to ensure finishing prior to the cut off time to qualify for awards.

Riders may choose to ride out in pairs or ride out in groups of 3 or more; however, only 2 of the riders will be eligible for awards.

Awards

Awards will be given to the top 6 finishers in each division at the conclusion of the Pace. Winners in each division will be determined by “closest to optimum time” for that division. Optimum times for this Pace will be slightly slower than usual because of the warmer weather.

Teams will be provided with maps of the course, and the course will be marked with ribbons. Entries will be limited to CVACTA members with one non-CVACTA member allowed per team. All riders must wear helmets and proper footwear with heels. It is also recommended that you carry a cell phone and emergency information on your person. Water will be provided for horses.
