Dressage show scores accepted by VADA-CH and VADA- Central Chapter

Combined Test Entry Fee: \$45 Per Level for non-members, \$40 per level for CVACTA members.

Dressage Competition Entry Fee: \$25 Per Test non-CVACTA members \$20 Per Test for CVACTA members.

Extra Stadium Rounds (non-judged): \$15 Per round, maximum 2 rounds per division

Late Fee \$10 (for entries received after September 5, dependant on available slots).

Dressage Tests: (All Dressage Tests will be ridden in a Small Arena)
Intro Level A & B, Training Level 1-4
Any USEA Test thru Preliminary Level

Combined Test Divisions: (All Dressage Tests will be ridden in a Small Arena)

Cross Rails: Dressage Test Intro Level Test B. Stadium obstacles will be plain cross rails not exceeding 18", 6-8 jumping efforts, not timed

Advanced Green: Dressage Test Intro Level Test B. Stadium obstacles not to exceed 2', may consist of verticals and gates with floral decorations, but no solid obstacles, 8- 10 jumping efforts, 300 mpm

Beginner Novice: USEF 2006 BN Test B, Stadium obstacles maximum height 2'7", 325 mpm.

Novice: USEF 2006 Novice Test B, Stadium obstacles maximum height 2'11", 350 mpm.

Training: USEF 2006 Training Test B, Stadium obstacles maximum height 3'3", 400 mpm.

Six ribbons awarded in each division. Classes may be combined per the discretion of the Show Manager. Horses can cross enter into separate divisions. Same horse can not be ridden in same division by a different rider.

Directions:

From South: Take Rt. 288 to Rt. 6/Patterson Rd. exit, going East (towards Richmond). At Blair Rd. (second right after exit from 288, just past cemetery), go right. Follow Blair Rd. until it dead-ends at a stop sign. Turn right onto River Rd. Tuckahoe is your first left. You will see white pillars and historic sign saying "Tuckahoe". Follow gravel drive down and go left at the fork, towards to the barn.

From East or West: I64 to Gaskins Road south exit. Right onto Gaskins Rd, straight to intersection with River Rd. Turn right onto River Rd and go 2.8 miles west to Blair Rd. Take the next left after Blair Rd. (You will see a small Tuckahoe Plantation sign and two white pillars). Follow gravel drive down and go left at the fork, towards to the barn.
