Beginner Novice: USEF 2010 BN Test B, Stadium obstacles maximum height 2'7", 300 mpm.

Novice: USEF 2010 Novice Test A, Stadium obstacles maximum height 2'11", 320 mpm.

Training: USEF 2010 Training Test A, Stadium obstacles maximum height 3'3", 325 mpm.

Preliminary: USEF 2010 Preliminary Test A , Stadium obstacles maximum height 3' 7", 350 mpm
