What is a Fix-a-Test?

You will ride your eventing or dressage test of choice in front of the judge, and receive a score, and feedback from the judge. Then you work through difficult areas of the test with some instruction, and re-ride the test. (Test may be called.)

I don't "do" Dressage.

That's fine! You can just come in the ring and discuss any particular movements or skills you want to work on, and Lucy will help.

Why should I do Dressage? I don't want to show.

Dressage simply means "preparation, or training". This training is beneficial for any horse in any discipline. It teaches the horse and rider to carry themselves properly and efficiently. The idea is to create a balanced, supple horse who is more likely to remain sound and safe.

What is the cost?

The cost of the first test is \$45 for USEA Area II Adult Rider members or Pony Club members, or \$50 for non-members. Membership forms will be available, and are included in the forms to sign up. This includes your test ride and instruction, test re-ride (within time limits), indoor ring fee, and lunch. We also encourage you to audit all the day's rides. There is a \$10 fee for non-riding auditors (includes lunch). Stalls will be available for \$10 each for the day, or \$20 overnight.

More details:

- Dress is casual, neat and tidy with ASTM hard hats at all times when mounted.
- Negative Coggins within 12 months required.
- Payment is due no later than one week before clinic date.
- Refunds will only be issued if your vacancy can be filled. No-shows = No Refund.
- Times available Wednesday before the event at wowgraphicdesigns.com/fixatest.
- Participants will be asked to help by scribing (helping judge score) and/or calling tests for other rides. This is also a good way to learn!
