Fees: Combined Test: \$45.00 per test
Dressage Test: \$20.00 per test
Extra Stadium Round: \$10.00 (only if in addition to a CT round- can be added day of show).
Note: CVACTA members save \$5 per horse/rider entry.

Exact ride times will be available on www.cvacta.org on or before September 11.

Awards: CT: Scored as two divisions- Juniors and Seniors. Six ribbons per division. Juniors defined as 18 years and under.
Dressage: Six ribbons awarded per test; Juniors and Seniors will be combined.

Directions: Take Rt. 288 to Rt. 6/Patterson Rd. exit, going East (towards Richmond). At Blair Rd. (second right after exit from 288, just past cemetery), go right. Follow Blair Rd. until it dead-ends at a stop sign. Turn right onto River Rd. Tuckahoe is your first left. You will see white pillars and historic sign saying "Tuckahoe". Follow gravel drive down and go left at the fork, towards to the barn.

Mix & Match CT: Pick one dressage test and level of stadium from those listed below to create your own CT.

C.T. Dressage: USDF Intro B, USEF Beginner Novice Test B, USEF Novice Test B, USEF Training Test B.

C.T. Stadium: Green: up to 2' (6-8 cross rails), Advanced Green: up to 2'3", Beginner Novice: up to 2'7", Novice: up to 2'11", Training: up to 3'4".

Dressage Show: Intro (USDF Intro A and Intro B), Training (USEF Training Level Tests 1-4).

Additional Notes:

1. LIABILITY WAIVER: Must be signed every person riding (competitor or otherwise). Riders under 18 must have their legal guardian sign waiver.
2. Coggins: each horse must have a valid, negative coggins- drawn within one year of competition date.
3. Horses must wear competitor numbers at all times while on the grounds.
4. Hard hats required at all times.
5. Management reserves right to combine classes as warranted.
6. Ambulance/Veterinarian WILL NOT be present on grounds.
7. Dress: Casual-boots, breeches, ASTM approved hard hats for juniors and for all riders in stadium.
8. Medical Arm-Band- required for stadium and in stadium warm-up.
