BOARD MEETING

FEBRUARY 26, 2009

- Hollyn Mangione called the meeting to order at 7:30.
- In attendance: Gina Sybert, Megan Holt, Megan Proffitt, Kristine Slovis, Pat Albertson, Beth Schooley and Pat Martin
- Hollyn introduced new level descriptions for the jumping courses at our CT events. After discussion, the Board accepted them as follows:
 1. Crossrails: 6-8 fences, crossrails, no floral decorations. Untimed.
 2. Introductory: 6-8 fences, 2'-2'3", up to 2 oxers, fences may not be wider than tall, may contain verticals, gates, panels and be decorated with flowers. No solid walls or rolltops. Timed at 300 mpm, but does not affect score.
 3. Beginner Novice: 2'7", 9-11 fences, the course should remain inviting, with up to 2 oxers. Walls and rolltops are permitted. May have one combination that cannot be less than 33' (2 strides). Timed at 300 mpm.
 4. Novice: 2'11", 10-12 fences, may contain combinations, timed at 320 mpm.
 5. Training: 3'3", 10-12 fences, Timed at 325 mpm.
 6. Preliminary 3'7", 11-13 fences, Timed at 350 mpm. Smaller arenas, time is 325 mpm.
- Cash on hand-\$4,504.73. \$90 owed to CSF for stabling. Hollyn announced the 2/21 CT at CSF will probably net around \$1,000.00. The Board voted to reimburse Hollyn for paying the dressage judge (Nicky Vogel) a cancellation fee for the January CT at CSF.
- Budget for the upcoming CT at CSF is \$850.00. Hollyn is working on an overall budget for the coming year.
- Discussion about speakers followed: Kristine Slovis is in discussion w/Barbra Wiefelstede about a possible talk on the training scales of dressage tests, fix-a-test, or clinic.
- Belinda Lloyd will do a talk at our general meeting on April 9th about gymnastics and walking courses.

- Dana Bivens from Campbell Springs will talk on studs.
- Pat M. will try to get Nancy Covert for a biting clinic for the May or June meeting.
- Hollyn amended the dressage test for the 3/14 CT at CSF for BN from Beginner Novice Test A to Beginner Novice Test B.
- Still need a speaker for March, working on getting Dr Barry of Woodside Equine- Pat Albertson will follow up on Hollyn's call to Dr. Barry to convince him to speak. He will hopefully come to speak on conformation and the event horse.
- Pat Martin needs to do flyers for mock trials and conditioning clinic.
- Beth Schooley will take minutes at the March Board meeting.
