

NOTICE OF INHERENT RISKS &
PARTICIPANT'S WAIVER OF RIGHT TO SUE

Tuckahoe Plantation Stables, Inc., pursuant to the Equine Activity Liability Act, Code of Virginia (1950), as amended Section 3.1-796.130, hereby notifies

_____ (Guardian of)* *participant* that participation in *equine activity* (horseback riding including lessons, trail riding, showing, jumping, dressage, hunting, etc.) is an inherently dangerous activity which can result in serious injury or death. The risks inherent in equine activities include (i) the propensity of an equine (horse or pony) to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to you, the participant; (ii) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or animals; and (iii) hazards of surface or subsurface conditions.

With full understanding of these risks and of my right to sue for negligent acts which could result in injury or death to me (my child)* in the absence of this waiver of my right to sue pursuant to the Equine Activity Liability Act, ***I hereby waive my right to sue Tuckahoe Plantation Stables, Inc., its officers, employees, agents or assigns, as provided in the Act, and hereby expressly assume all risks inherent in equine activity.***

I understand that this waiver shall remain valid and in force unless I expressly revoke it by notifying Tuckahoe Plantation Stables, Inc., in writing, signed and dated, that I revoke this waiver. The waiver shall be binding on my heirs, assigns, or personal representative.
